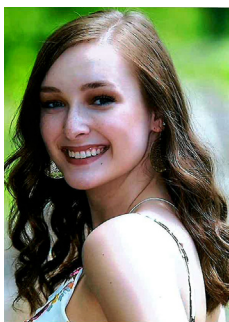

Central District

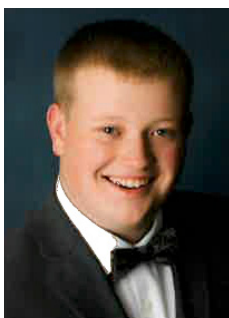

East Central

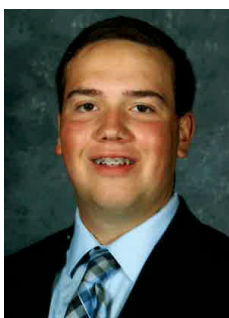
